Martial Cottle Park - Design Presentation

The Santa Clara County Parks Department will be holding a public meeting related to the design of Martial Cottle Park located in South San Jose, Santa Clara County. At this meeting, the current design for the Park will be presented and the public will have an opportunity to provide comments.

The Martial Cottle Design Presentation meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 10, 2012, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. at the Forum/Cafeteria at Gunderson High School, 622 Gaundabert Lane, San Jose, California, 95136.



Project Location

The Santa Clara County Parks Department and California State Parks jointly own Martial Cottle Park. This future park is a 287.54-acre property adjacent to Highway 85, bounded by Branham Lane, Snell Avenue and Chynoweth Avenue. In accordance with the property transfer agreement with the Donor of the Park, and the Joint Powers and Operating Agreement approved by the County and the State, the Parks Department is developing the design for a historic agricultural park consistent with the Donor's Vision. This design is guided by

the Martial Cottle Park State Park General Plan and County Park Master Plan and EIR approved in 2011. Phase 1 design includes perimeter and interior trails, public recreation areas, irrigation and infrastructure supporting agricultural elements of the park, visitor center and other park operations and maintenance facilities.

Purpose of Design Presentation Meeting

Members of the community and interested agency representatives are invited to the Design Presentation meeting to learn more about the Phase 1 design. The Parks Department is interested in receiving general public comments on the current design, which is presently in the Design Development phase. The public will have an opportunity to hear a presentation on the overall design, review the design elements in more detail and submit comments for discussion at the meeting.
