The San Jose Planning Division is hosting a community open house (1) to present and explain a proposed draft citywide Land Use/Transportation Diagram (“map”) including new land use designations to show areas of San Jose proposed for growth and established neighborhoods *not* proposed for growth, and (2) to get your input on how clearly the draft Diagram communicates the vision of the General Plan Update. The Land Use/Transportation Diagram illustrates the types of uses which could be allowed in your neighborhood, such as stores or townhouses, or whether lots could be subdivided to build additional homes. Come join the dialogue and tell us what you think!
