The County of Santa Clara, Parks and Recreation Department has initiated the development of a Grazing Plan for Santa Teresa County Park in south San Jose. The goals of the Grazing Plan are to return cattle to the park in order to manage the serpentine grassland habitats that host a number of federal and State listed plant species and the federally listed Bay Checkerspot Butterfly.

In addition, the Grazing Plan addresses management of annual grasslands and oak woodlands for the benefit of native species, management of wildfire risks, control of non-native plant species; while addressing continuing public access to these special areas. This draft Grazing Plan is in response to the need to manage these special habitats as well as the implementation of the USFWS's Recovery Plan for Serpentine Species of the San Francisco Bay Area.

Members of the community and interested representatives are invited to this meeting to learn more about the Grazing Plan and provide their input on the Plan.

The public meeting is scheduled from **5:30 to 7:00 PM on June 8, 2011** at Santa Teresa Golf Club, Upper Club House, 260 Bernal Road San Jose CA. 95119

Directions: From Hwy 85, exit at Bernal Road, heading south towards the Santa Teresa Hills. The entrance to the golf course is approximately ¼ mile passed Santa Teresa Blvd. intersection on the LEFT. Turn LEFT to enter the Santa Teresa Golf Club Course. At the Y intersection, go to the LEFT and continue up the hill into the Upper Club House parking lot.
